



- What is the total impact on overheads and capital spending



Income deductions

Jobbing

Mobilise people to work together or individually to complete a task they believe in

Kit

Assemble a fundraising kit so that fundraising supporters can avail of the resource to help them raise money effectively.

Mental Health Ireland send fundraising kits to their volunteers

Prepare your own guidelines, marketing materials, forms and anything else that makes it easy for anyone to raise money for you.

Lottery

Create a lottery where people donate regularly and enter a weekly draw NCBI Eye Can Lottery

Set up direct debit regular contribution and make sure you have and permit

Membership

Invite people to become fee paying members, in return for information, events and special treatment

Clubs and Co-operatives

Merchandise

Christmas cards, post cards etc.
