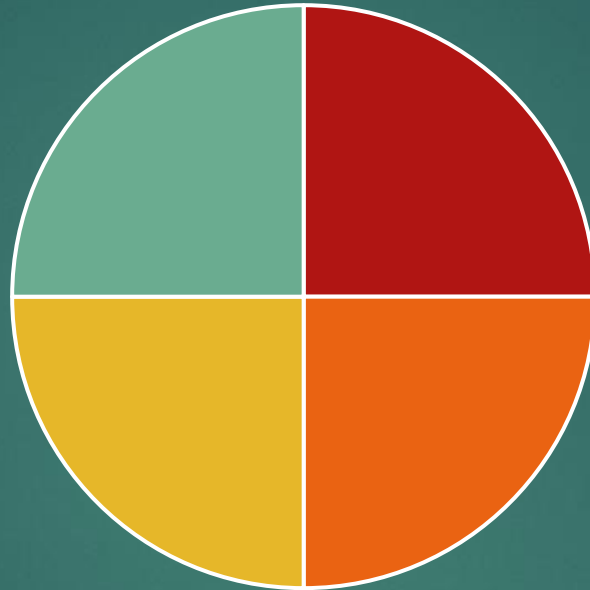

Set up a Merchant Account with an acquirer

Pay a % of each donation received plus an authorisation fee of 3- 4 cents depending on which acquirer chosen

e.g. at fee of 0.40% for Visa debit this would equate to 4 cent per €10.00 donation plus a 3 cent auth fee = 7 cents per €10.00 donation

PCI fee of €4.50 or €4.40 per month depending on acquirer

To set up an account the following are often required:

- Charity registration number
- Proof of ID for signing principals (director or chairperson)
- Name of committee members/board if applicable
- Proof of trading (banking statements)

The Charity can rent different types of terminals including GPRS, Wireless and countertop allowing them to Tap to Donate

Costs starting from a current offer of €9.99 per month with no contract and no monthly minimum

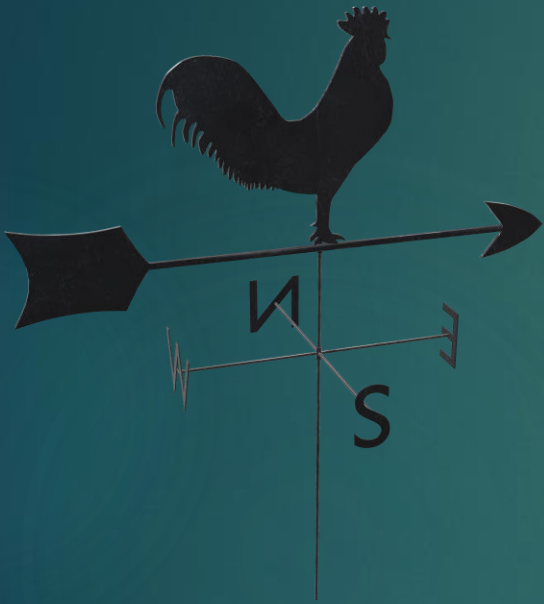
