Introduction

Co Wicklow PPN consulted with community groups in the Wicklow Municipal District on their vision for community wellbeing. As part of the consultation process Co Wicklow PPN held workshops in An Tairseach Ecology Centre, Annamoe Community Centre and The Pastoral Centre Wicklow Town. Groups were asked - "What are your hopes and aspirations for your community in the future under the Community Wellbeing Headings"? Their responses are below.

Coastal Protection

- The Murrough still to be here
- Coastal Protection/erosion of the Murrough

Enterprise & Sustainability

- Small enterprises

Protect & Nurture Our Environment

Local Economies

- More encouragement to shop locally
- We want more variety (To be able to shop locally) (travel agent, furniture, shoes & underwear)
- To add a baker a greengrocer
- More open shops in town

Enterprise Support

- **Tourism** management – transport access
- Communities need to look at how to improve tourism and planning in their area
- Tourism needs to hold people longer (Too many day trippers: Rathdrum needs a hotel more accommodation)
- Support arts business

Community Supports

- State support for community groups to link with youth unemployment
- Insurance to change to enable flexibility (ICA/Transition Year)
- Link youth & unemployed to Mens Sheds, ICA, Women's Groups etc for skills networking

Inclusion

- More inclusive community
- Equal access – work to remove barriers
- Challenge to make sure no one is left out if not involved in a group
- Some of new communities hidden in private estates – challenge to address
- Festivals that get communities together
- Open days
- Get people to be open to change and open to all sectors of community

- Want to see Disadvantaged get more support (Developing mindfulness walk in Ballard)

Volunteering

- Properly resourced volunteer centre
- Support & Resource Community & Voluntary sector
- Voluntary groups are supported to do their work
- More volunteers – inter generational
- People are terrified to volunteer – afraid of getting trapped (that they wouldn't be able to leave their volunteer role)

Supporting Communities

- More resources, funding training, support
- Men's Shed – community support for men
- CEART – great support for Travellers
- Adequate funding for community and social sector
- Support to comply with requirements e.g. Charitable status, GDPR
- On the ground resources
- Support groups to work together and with agencies. Provide resources and skills
- Less Bureaucracy – small groups crippled by garda vetting, health and safety.

State Support

- More support for family unit – childcare/further education/jobs
- More support for youth groups to gain access into colleges
- CW & Tus opportunity/support for training & progressions
- Need to remove the under 26 payment on social welfare
- Standard payment of doctor etc
- Work to address/remove poverty gap

Community Facilities

- Place for young people to gather that is not sport or alcohol based
- Communal spaces on estates that encourage multi-generational use
- Support charity shops/space for people to meet
- Benches for people to pause, sit, talk, people watch
- Walkable town/MD
- Cinema/Arts Centre
- Adequate Community space

PPN

- Challenge to get people to share information
- Focus groups for people not in groups
- PPN to support community in planning matters

Transport & Infrastructure

- Route to be determined by community groups
- Trains – extended service – dart to Wicklow – (infrequent services)
- Better rural transport – bus availability – better routes
- Regular affordable access – primary care centre Wicklow
- Want to walk, but taking life in hands, need footpaths. speed limits need to be reviewed.
- Cycle Paths and Speed ramps
- Local link buses
- Rural Transport bus – more flexibility and availability

Natural Environment

- Coastal protection on the Murrough
- Safe & natural environment for play
- Upgrade existing walks – river walk & Whitfield lane
- Don't dump plastic bottles

Inclusion

- A lot of isolation outside large towns
- Autism, old age, mental health
- Acceptance that difference is natural and celebrated

Facilities

- Day-care facilities
- Refurbish old buildings rather than leave derelict

Less litigation – Health & Safety

Housing

- Access to affordable appropriate Housing
- Supported to remain at home
- To adapt home to different stages of life

Support Carers

- Supportive environment/group/network for Carers
- More respite for carers
- More day centres

Mental Health

- More mental health services/funding for services for young people
- More coordinated services
- Supports for Jigsaw & Pieta House mental health services
- Psychological & psychiatric services are not accessible & have long waiting lists
- Challenge the school system to relieve pressure experienced by young people
- Encourage young people to look at bigger picture not just college etc

State supports

- Focus on prevention not waiting for problem to arise
- More localised services – working clinic one day per week
- Space for people in services e.g. disabilities – nursing homes etc
- No waiting lists for services for any one incl people with disabilities & older people
- Paid youth workers that can support youth health
- Community health workers
- Fully integrated health centre
- Family supports & services – more social workers
- Universal health system – no private health care – affordable healthcare
- More support/care hours per person

Industry

- Industry to support clean environment & good health

Community based health

- Community services link with Bluebird care/ Home instead
- Mainstream funding of all community-based health supports/programmes
- Edible estates – link with tidy towns
- Affordable complementary health activities

Recreation

- Community sports centre & general facility for all groups
- Wicklow Partnership to develop existing groups

Community Supports

- Affordable Social Outlets
- Social Activities, social groups supporting people's health through engagement, reduce isolation
- Make community halls available
- Make halls disability friendly (support needed)
- Mens sheds – supporting mens health

- Keep people active. This is a good place to be old, lots going on
- Keeping active – better than any drug

- Promote & support everyone's culture – involve new communities – culture sharing
- Women of the World Group – sharing experience & culture

Natural Environment

- Respect & love of nature & environment
- Education about natural environment
- Fisheries Board to be active clearing rivers

Funding

- Fiscal contribution to enable people to engage in culture/tradition/crafts

Education & Awareness

- Link with KWETB to promote traditional crafts
- More access/funding towards: language, dance, crafts, sports

Irish Culture

- Fluidity to understanding of what it means to be Irish/Wicklow person
- Value & celebrate our Irish culture
- We want our society to promote our culture
- Bring our culture alive
- Folklore – keep and share
- Local history and culture recorded to pass on
- Capture information from older people, record them, Centre to do this

Inclusion

- Inclusive society ; everybody equal and can voice opinion

Heritage

- All Community centres should have goal to protect heritage of area. Avoid GDPR barrier
- Preserve Build Heritage

Civic Engagement

- PPN should have a seat on Heritage Forum
- Statutory Bodies need to involve Community reps.

Participation, Democracy & Good Governance

Consultation & Collaboration

- Respect members of community
- Promote better involvement on public consultations
- Genuine/meaningful public engagement
- Local Authority/Local Council to hear & meaningful respect for groups
- Consultation with children & young people
- Real collaboration
- Community want to be heard.
- Council to act in relation to what community is suggesting
- The County Council to communicate with the community – lines of communication to be open
- Want a better say in our communities especially re planning
- Councillors should engage with community – let people know what is planned

Community Support

- Support & coordinate local group development
- Someone to support groups
- Local Authority/Local Council to support local groups (resource staff & money)
- More recognition of voluntary work, volunteers supported

Bureaucracy

- Less bureaucracy, more efficient easier joined up [paperwork]
- Easier access to medical cards
- Too much responsibility/pressure on volunteers – H&S, child protection, GDPR etc

Elected Representatives

- Mandatory training for public representatives in participation, democracy & good governance
- Councillors to get more cultural awareness training
- A local TD that works for the community
- Active Committed Councillors

Housing

- Need local services, facilities & infrastructure to support housing
- Change in system Re renovation of council housing (6 month delay –govt will pay)
- Council to have own authority Re decision in housing etc

Transparency & Accountability

What authority?

A local government we can trust

- A question time for the public
- Tenders for public money to be published – person who is awarded the contract
- Stop point scoring
- Council sharing information freely
- Stop wasting money – bad spending
- End corruption in councils & statutory bodies
- Transparency & accountability of councillors
- Minutes to be published on line
- Openness & transparency of all publicly funded organisations
- More efficient in processing issues
- Community groups should have access to planners (just like developers can) save going to an Bord Pleanála

PPN
