Networking/ Working Locally	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The PPN in collaboration with Disability Federation Ireland, Wicklow Children &amp; Young Peoples Services Committee, Bray Area Partnership, Co Wicklow Partnership and Cllr. Miriam Murphy put together a proposal containing a tender to engage a consultant to develop a guide for community groups and service providers that would support them to be more inclusive of people with disabilities. The proposal was presented to the WCC Disability &amp; Inclusion Committee seeking their support. The committee included this in a funding application to the Department of Children, Equality, Disability Integration and Youth to support disability services in the county. The application was successful and work on this will begin in 2022</li> </ul>
Networking/ Working Regionally, & Nationally	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The National Conference Subgroup met 8/12. The group agreed to cancel the National Conference scheduled to take place 4<sup>th</sup> &amp; 5<sup>th</sup> March 2022. Due to the continually changing landscape as a result of the pandemic it was agreed that the Conference should not be re-scheduled until there are no doubts about the safety of running a large event. It is hoped that the Conference will take place in Wicklow in 2023</li> <li>• In November Co Wicklow PPN invited key people in the County together to explore and discuss options for making an application under the Community Climate Action Programme: Climate Education, Capacity Building and Learning by Doing (Strand 2) Scheme for Co. Wicklow. Those present agreed to explore the idea of accessing the funding to support Sustainable Energy Communities (SECs) to implement their Energy Master Plans. Since then, conversations &amp; meetings have taken place with PPNs, SECs and SEC Mentors in Kildare and Meath as well as possible lead organisations including IEN, Three Energy, NUI Maynooth, and Irish Rural Link. There is interest in progressing an application for funding to support SECs in counties Wicklow, Kildare and Meath to progress past the development of their Energy Plans to implementation stage. Irish Rural Link has agreed to take the lead role in the funding application. A small group will meet in the first week of January to pull together a framework for the funding proposal. This will be quickly followed with meetings with SECs in the 2<sup>nd</sup> &amp; 3<sup>rd</sup> week of January. The funding application will be built on as we go along and submitted for the deadline of 27<sup>th</sup> January (an extension of the original 14<sup>th</sup> January date).</li> </ul>

Members were given the opportunity to network in small groups to share their 2021 experiences. Retiring Secretariat members were thanked, and new Secretariat members were welcomed to the second part of the meeting</li> <li>• Liaison Subgroup meeting 16/12. A final review of 2021 workplan and finance and discussions for 2022.</li> </ul>
