The following is a brief outline of some of the work of the GFRC and how it aligns with the 17 Sustainable Development Goals framework



GFRC has partnered with the Hygiene Bank Ireland to source essential hygiene products and provide this to families who absolutely cannot afford them.



GFRC has engaged some women from the Ukrainian community who are living with host Irish families. They ran a week of wellness and wellbeing for the mothers while their children were attending summer camps run by local volunteers. This included yoga, head massage, a trip to Mount Usher Gardens and an opportunity to connect with each other and seek further supports from GFRC.



GFRC supports the work of Bray Women's Refuge to support and empower women who are victims of domestic violence. GFRC and also provides individual support to parents who are mostly women in NVR training.



Other goals to which GFRC are currently aligned are



GFRC works with a number of families to access childcare services and to source sponsorship for those who cannot afford it.

GFRC has also worked in partnership with the Whale Theatre in Greystones to provide access to social and cultural events to those who would not otherwise participate.

GFRC took part in the Greystones Multicultural Festival held in August. This was a great event to highlight the many different cultures and non Irish communities now living in Greystones and to give them an equal platform for celebration in the community.



GFRC has partnered with Bray Area Partnership to provide English language classes to all non Irish communities.
