The **Store Cupboard** in Grange Con offers people an opportunity every Saturday to purchase a wide range of goods without packaging.

The Store Cupboard offers the option to refill, preventing the generation of packaging waste. During the planting/harvesting seasons they leave a stand in our village with surplus seeds, seedlings and/or harvested fruit & veg. Community members are free to take any of these that they will use, and leave any of their own surplus seeds, seedlings, fruit or veg. They also have a **Terracycle recycling** collection box at the same spot. People can drop in their empty crisp, biscuit, cracker, cake and/or confectionary packets (soft plastics only) and they send these off to be recycled.

A second Go Greener Grange Con campaign is **Choose to Reuse** encouraging the use of reusable coffee cups in the local café and shop. They also have a party pack which can be borrowed for children's parties preventing the need for disposable items. A campaign delivering practical solution for the community that facilitate Responsible Consumption & Production (SDG 12).
