Services – Lost CWO to Athy, primary care centre not staffed & don't know the services

Town Park- boardwalk and playground need repair and regular safety checks

Walking routes- Lords Wood welcome and well used addition but there are possible opportunities along the river joining wier to town park.

Healthy Heart walk in town

There are several walks folk do here- Weaver square to green lane and back- need more street lighting from lathleer to the hospital, trimming of edge of road green lane.

Bawnogues- out rathvilly Road turn onto castledermott Road and back in behind the Garda Station turn right back into town at the main cross roads. - hedge trimming required on back road

Sruthaun -up past graveyard out to n81 and back into town safety issues on N81 stretch.

Gym space/investment incentive- there is no local gym several have tried to set up but rents have been an issue. No outdoor gym equipment -could be an addition to the playground.

Burden of bureaucracy on small voluntary groups

Communication & Information

No central community notice board. Very difficult to spread the word re events plus difficult to find out about events esp if you are new to the area. No newsletter covering the actual hinterland-baltinglass/kiltegan/castledermot/Stratford/ Rathvilly /possibly dunlavin.

Suggestion - Large external centrally located community notice board - information hub-a supervised desk space(Leader or CE scheme) where tourist info could be located plus a central co-ordinating point for a local newsletter- eg- www.westkerrylive.ie free fortnightly newsletter distributed throughout South kerry.

Investing in cultural opportunities will be largely wasted unless the communications issue is resolved.. build it and they will come IF they know about it!

Broadband – many places have none/bad broadband&? to depend on

New health centre – No GPs – no specialist – no xray – not wheelchair friendly limited GP service (not in health centre) no consultant service.

New Community Centre & Sports Campus like shoreline – feasibility study (with CWP) – Basketball club 390 children nowhere to practise – amenity at the river – adult exercise equipment

Social Enterprise

Social Enterprise – social community & economic impact. Gaps: can be CE dependent not enough business for "pantry" to be viable- dependent on volunteers to run it – Feels like we don't have the right support for it

Social Enterprise - profit of some sort needs to be made cant? totally on volunteers

Social Enterprise – Stratfor Grange Con – did a lot of research & visited many around the county – has to be a business – has to earn money – what do people want to have to provide it for them

Social Enterprise/CE Scheme CE was involved but had to be supervised – difficult & time consuming – problems – lost volunteers because of it (Rathdangan & Kiltegan) - CE scheme has to run well (Stratford/Grangecon area) – The responsibility is huge on groups

No jobs in Baltinglass – people travelling out of the town

CE Scheme – no CE workers available in centres to work – needed

Community service – contract be bought in?

RRDF – works starting on first July

Transport – access to health services & supports

Health Facilities & Resources (Education & Prevention)

Doctors based in one place – ie The Primary Health Centre – can't get a doctor

Doctors – GPS – scarcity – long wait for appointments

Baltinglass hospital physio - in PHC

Local services not flowing/connected

Need to travel for Health Service – optician once a week in Baltinglass

Primary Health Centre – to provide full range of health services/supports – complete service in PHC – Triage Service – local A&E type service

PHC to provide complete health service and services to be permanently based there.

PHC – Arklow good example – Blessington & Baltinglass issues

Chemists – local access to 24 hour chemist

PHC needs to offer full service – 7 day element to service - Doctors available

Local doctors to join Care Doc service

Keep hospital (respite & day care) in town

Communication & Accessibility

Need to share information/communicate what is available locally

Community Notice board – communication- identify how people access information

Mental Health Policy & Practice

Mental health services support - non existent – issue – when do you start to address – Consider within context of a whole societal Task – eg need to support people re purpose in life etc

Sli an Croi counsellors – support to meet local needs & get involved with local community

Prevention/support services locally for all health needs (eg. Addiction, mental health)

Mental health – child psychology only visits once a month – services need to be supplied/enhanced

Mental Health – support services needed for mental health needs eg wexford service – community based service

Better mental health services, more on prevention, woodlands for health
