**Representation**

How PPNs enhance/impact the democratic process/nation? Role and impact of the PPN in policy development/ What supports are available to PPN Reps to represent the voices of community?

- Individual bringing the proposal/issues forward from their groups Re supports/services in the community
- PPN voices on LCDC, SPCs, JPC, PPN Secretariat, Boards & Committees. Impact/Submission from grassroots
- Regular communication with PPN Resource Worker for support
- Deliver presentation on SPC jointly with our PPN, rotate chair every 3 months, flat structure supports inclusivity & everyone's voice is welcome
- PPNs can impact democratic process by bringing the local community issues to the local authority
- Policy development in differentiated policy development can result in adverse impacts on some communities. PPN can add this as their members are community activists in their own areas
- PPN Reps are supported by PPN staff and other community groups in the different colleges to articulate the issues for local communities.
- Submissions – establish thematic /linkage groups
- Run rep day meets. Introduction course in conjunction with county council
- End of meeting 5-10 bullet points, main outcome of meeting. Introduced in all committees
- Pre meet before SPC with Resource Worker. Secretariat manages the finances

- Independent PPN, Close working relationship, Resource Worker works with county council hoping to improve how SPC work, Developing SPC rules – SPC Agenda – rights of PPN to put things on agenda

## **Participation**

- Local voices in local development

- Boundaries, Confidence, Language, acronyms, no collaboration
- Voice heard, influencing decision making & policy development, working group meets with council, people at table for decisions
- Encourage Reps, Work jointly, Collaborative work
- Submission/request with council for what county wants.
