<b>Work/Activities</b>	<p>Community development, health and wellbeing initiatives. – both drop in and structured programmes and initiatives. These include weekly cuppa and chat, Cheile Community Choir, Age friendly programmes and supports.</p> <p>Family Support and access to a range of supports for disadvantaged families provided both directly and in conjunction with relevant service providers and local organisations.</p> <p>Adult Education Access Programme, which offers a wide range of education and training programmes and ongoing support and information to enable local people access mainstream education opportunities.</p> <p>Management and development of Connect Bray Neighbourhood Youth Project that targets young people in the community through the provision of a Drop-In service and youth development services.</p> <p>Provision of a Welfare Rights Information and Referral Service that provides confidential information and support on a wide range of issues.</p> <p>Crèche and After School Programmes to provide high quality supports to the most disadvantaged children in the community. This service also supports parents accessing education, training and employment opportunities</p> <p>Employment supports for those most distanced from the labour market and long term employed. This includes A C.E. Project that offers unemployed people in the Community through their participation, the opportunity to gain skills and training which will enable them to access permanent employment.</p> <p>Support to Community Based Childcare providers through the Provision of CE Childcare Staff.</p>
